

CUSSCARDS™ CHARADES



CUSSCARDS™ Charades is a take on the classic game of pantomimes - only spicier! “Act out” words and phrases, without speaking, while the other players try to guess what the hell you are doing.

Tip: **CUSSCARDS™** Charades makes waiting fun. Next time you and your friends are out to eat and find yourself wondering what’s taking so long, turn your annoying wait into a fun game with **CUSSCARDS™** Charades.

Objective

The aim is to be the first to guess the **CUSSCARDS™** word or phrase.

Players and Cards

The game is played by 2 or more players (the more the merrier) using **CUSSCARDS™** European Edition 52 card deck.

Deal

A shuffled deck of **CUSSCARDS™** is placed in the center of the players.

Play

The first player draws the top card from the face down **CUSSCARDS™** deck without revealing the card to the other players. After reviewing the card, he/she (the Actor) places the card face down in the discard pile and must act out the word or phrase on that card without speaking (sound are OK). The remaining players (the Guessers) each try to be the first to guess what is being acted out.

The first player to guess correctly becomes the Winning Guesser. All Losing Guessers must pay a price. You can play for fun, money, or honor. Feel free to make your own rule.

Some examples of game rules are:

All Losing Guessers must take a drink.

All Losing Guessers must put a quarter/dollar in the pot.

All Losing Guessers must give a compliment to the winning guesser.

Gameplay resumes as the Winning Guesser becomes the Actor of the next round, taking the next face down card in the shuffled deck.

Endgame

The game continues until every player has had a chance to “act out” at least one **CUSSCARDS™** word or phrase or until your wait is over, whichever comes first.

NO SPEAKING...We mean it! Don't give up! Use your creativity and you can successfully act your way through the entire deck. We know...we've done it!

If you need a hand...

Gestures:

- **Number of words:** Hold up the number of fingers.
- **Which word you're working on:** Hold up the number of fingers again.
- **Number of syllables in the word:** Lay the number of fingers on your arm.
- **Which syllable you're working on:** Lay the number of fingers on your arm again.
- **Length of word:** Make a "little" or "big" sign as if you were measuring a fish.
- **"The entire concept:"** sweep your arms through the air.
- **"On the nose"** (i.e., someone has made a correct guess): point at your nose with one hand, while pointing at the person with your other hand.
- **"Sounds like":** Cup one hand behind an ear.
- **"Longer version of:"** Pretend to stretch a piece of elastic.
- **"Shorter version of:"** Do a "karate chop" with your hand
- **"Plural":** link your little fingers.
- **"Past tense":** wave your hand over your shoulder toward your back.
